



EDU903 Cooperating Teacher Training (1 credit)

Corban University is excited to present an opportunity to earn graduate credit through mentoring a teacher candidate. EDU903: Cooperating Teacher Training provides foundational preparation for classroom teachers serving in the role of Cooperating Teachers for Student Teachers (Teacher Candidates) providing beneficial insights into developing professional relationship in any teacher mentoring role. The course is available in the fall and spring semesters, although transcription of the completed course can take up to eight weeks.

Submission for Credit

In order to receive 1-credit for this course from Corban University, the following steps must be completed:

1. Apply and Register for the course at:

 - a. If you have previously been a student at Corban University, please note that in the appropriate place registration form so the system will link your records.
2. In 48-72 hours, you will receive an email regarding your account and setting up a login for *Populi*, which is Corban's learning management system. Establish your *Populi* login and check to see that EDU903 appears in your courses.
3. You will have completed all course modules during the Clinical Teacher Academy Training.
4. Complete all Module Reflections & the Final Paper.
5. Submit Module Reflections & Final Paper on *Populi* in the Assignment tab for EDU903.
6. Look for a bill in the mail (\$99 per credit) – you may pay online through the *Populi* system or by mailing a check to Corban University.
